

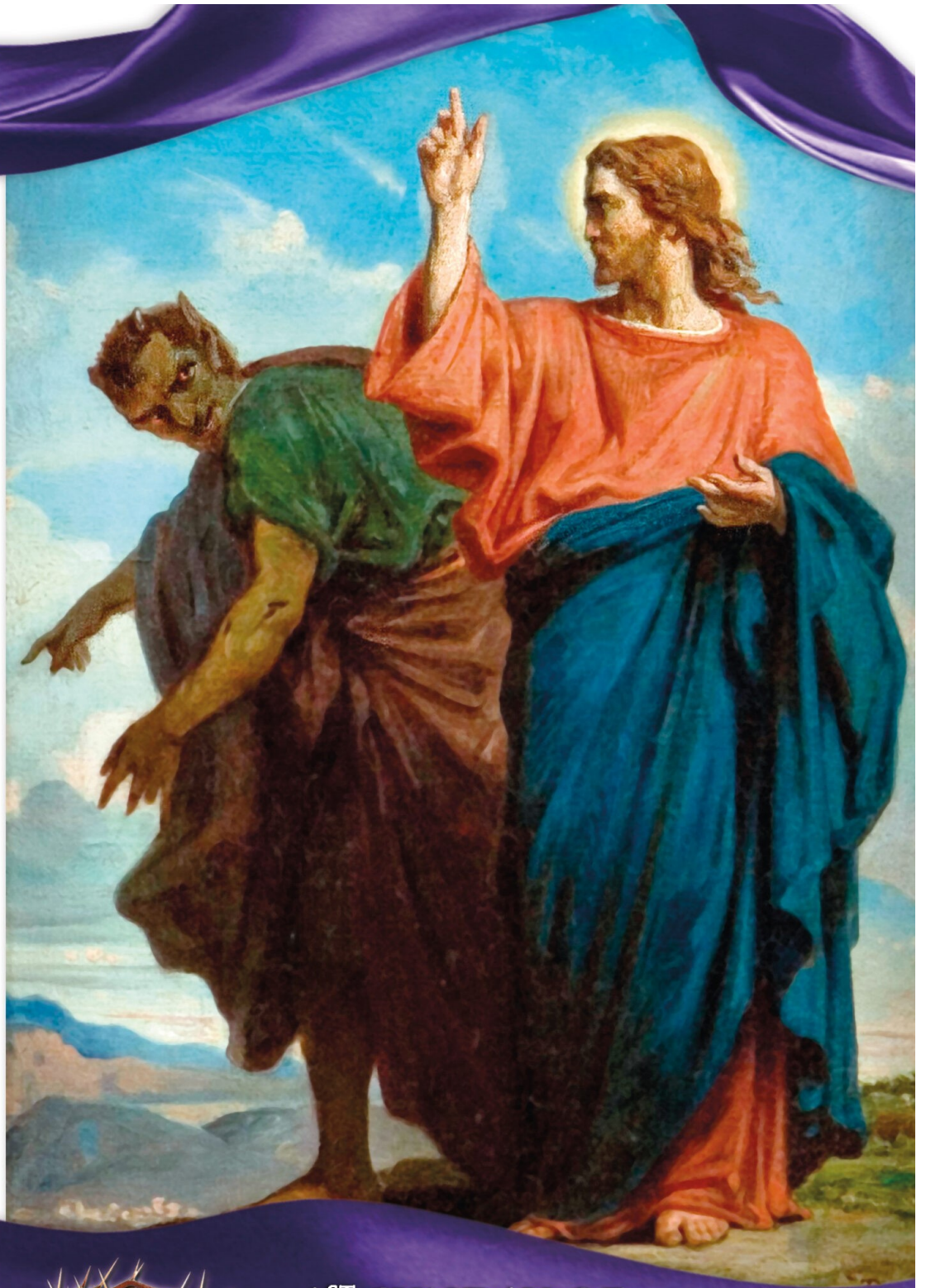

**Lent is the perfect time to fast from sin**

*Fasting from food during Lent should also include fasting from sinful behaviors.*

Lent is a beautiful season in the Church to recommit our lives to God. While the Church has certain days dedicated to fasting and abstinence from food during Lent, this discipline should not neglect the spiritual aspect of our lives.

**Fasting in a bodily way is supposed to remind and strengthen us to “fast” from our own sinful behaviors.**

The author of the 19th-century book *The Lenten Manual and Companion for Holy Week* explains how fasting is a means to an end, and that end is the elimination of sin in our lives.

*Fasting, however, is but a means to an end; and that great end is the **destruction of sin**. We should fast as an atonement for sin, and we should fast to prevent the danger of falling into sin, **For unless we fast from sin, all our fasting will be in vain**. Do not, therefore, dearly beloved brethren, fast like hypocrites, with the body only, but **preserve your souls from the CONTINUED ON PAGE 9***

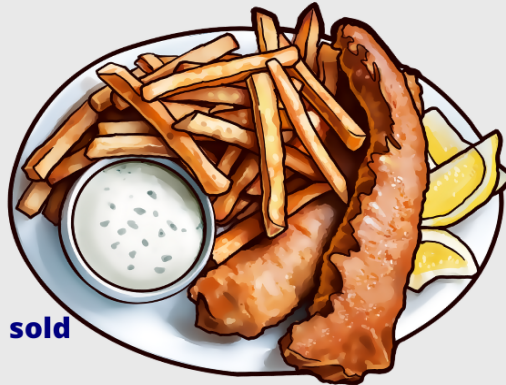

New Covenant that Christ enacted on the cross. We reflect on the suffering and death of Christ, we fast and abstain, and we pray, in order that our hearts might be more ready for the covenant that God has for us.

Instead of reliving history and breaking the small commitments God asks of us, Lent is a time to dive deeply into these commitments so that his covenant can ring true in our hearts and we will be

ready for it. Even Jesus as the Son of God knew how important it would be for us to slow down and reflect on what is most important. ## Alianza y Compromiso

A primera vista puede parecer un poco extraño que el primer domingo de Cuaresma tenga una lectura sobre la alianza de Dios con Noé. Todos sabemos la historia. Dios envió un diluvio para arrasar la tierra debido a su pecado y desobediencia y luego Dios hizo un pacto con su pueblo de nunca más enviar un diluvio que destruyera la tierra. Entonces, ¿por qué la Iglesia ha elegido esta lectura para la Cuaresma? ¿No se trata sólo de sufrimiento y no del plan amoroso de Dios para su pueblo?

Bueno, creo que esta lectura encaja perfectamente en esta temporada penitencial. Una y otra vez en el Antiguo Testamento vemos a Dios promulgando alianzas con su pueblo, y una y otra vez vemos a los seres humanos rompiendo esas alianzas. Dios quiere dar su vida y su amor y nosotros, como raza humana, nos apresuramos a darle la espalda y romper el compromiso de la alianza.

Veo la Cuaresma como un tiempo de preparación para la Pascua y esta Fiesta Santa celebra la culminación de la Nueva Alianza que Cristo promulgó en la cruz. Reflexionamos sobre el sufrimiento y la muerte de Cristo, ayunamos, nos abstenemos y oramos, para que nuestro corazón esté más preparado para la alianza que Dios tiene para nosotros.

En lugar de revivir la historia y romper los pequeños compromisos que Dios nos pide, la Cuaresma es un tiempo para ir más a fondo en estos compromisos para que su alianza pueda sonar verdadera en nuestros corazones y estemos preparados para ello. Incluso Jesús, como Hijo de Dios, sabía lo importante que sería para nosotros detenernos y reflexionar sobre lo que es más importante. No tuvo que pasar tiempo en el desierto, pero el Evangelio de hoy nos recuerda que de todos modos fue allí. Nos da el ejemplo de lo que significa ser fiel a su Padre celestial.

En esta Cuaresma, te animo a ti y a mí a ir más a fondo. Permitamos que este sea un tiempo de purificación y penitencia para que cuando llegue el tiempo de Pascua sepamos verdaderamente lo que significa alegrarnos.

**contamination of sin.** Otherwise you may be forced to say to the Lord, with the Prophet, "Why have we fasted, and you have not regarded; have we humbled our souls and you have not taken notice?" And he will answer, "Behold, in the day of your fast your own will is found." (Isai. lviii. 3.)

One practical way to focus our attention on the sins in our lives that need to be eliminated is to chose one stubborn sin we want to work on. It could be a sin that has become a habit in your life and that you want to stop.

Don't try eliminate all sin from your life, as that will set you up for failure. However, focusing on one particular sin is most beneficial and can lead to a very fruitful Lent.
