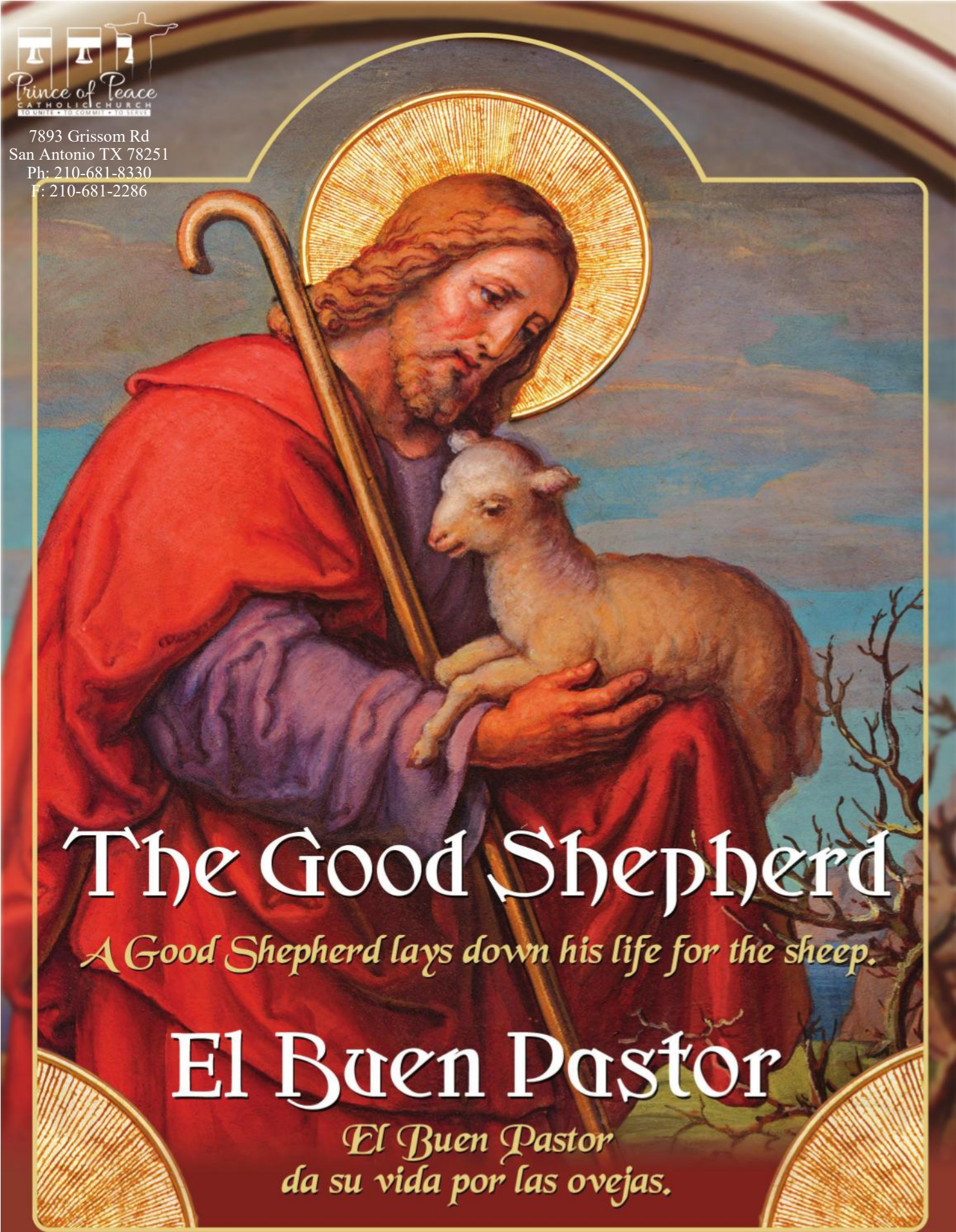

Happy Anniversary!

We are celebrating the 150th Anniversary of the Establishment of the Diocese of San Antonio! This significant milestone is a testament to the enduring faith, deeply rooted Catholic heritage, and untold blessings from God that have shaped this local Church through 150 years of missionary discipleship.

Did you know...

- The first recorded Mass in Texas was celebrated on May 16, 1675, during the Bosque de Larios expedition at a site north of present day Del Rio.
- In 1874, Pope Pius IX divided the then single Texas diocese based in Galveston to create the Diocese of San Antonio. Read the text of the papal decree.
- **The central celebration of the 150th Anniversary will be the Assembly: Archdiocesan Eucharistic Congress October 26, 2024**

Plenary Indulgence Granted to Faithful

In occasion of the Anniversaries of the Archdiocese of San Antonio

The Holy Father Pope Francis has granted the faithful a Plenary Indulgence for the sesquicentennial (150th) anniversary of canonical erection of the Diocese of San Antonio, created on August 28, 1874, as well as the centennial (100th) anniversary of the elevation to Metropolitan Archdiocese of San Antonio on August 3rd, 1926. The indulgence is valid between January 1, 2024, and December 31, 2026. The baptized faithful who commit to detachment of sin and follow the steps according to the teaching and law of the Catholic Church, receive this indulgence by **being in the state of grace at the completion of the prescribed works below:**

- Devoutly visiting a designated site and pray the Our Father and recite the Creed
- Meeting the three usual conditions of sacramental confession, Eucharistic Communion (receiving Holy Communion), and prayer for the intention of

the Pope

- Those who are unable due to age, illness, or other circumstances to leave their home can gain the indulgence by spiritually joining themselves to the anniversary celebrations and offering their sufferings to God

The designated sites are:

- The Cathedral of San Fernando San Antonio, TX: One of the oldest continuous functioning cathedrals in the United States
- St. Mary Catholic Church Fredericksburg, TX: A beautiful and historic church located in the heart of the Texas Hill Country
- Sacred Heart Catholic Church Uvalde, TX: The community that experienced the horrific school shooting of nineteen students and two teachers in 2022. It is a community in need of healing.
- St. James Catholic Church Gonzales, TX: A community

of faith located in the eastern part of the Archdiocese. It is here where the battle cry for Texas Independence was initially heard.

- Immaculate Conception of the Blessed Virgin Mary Catholic Church

Panna Maria, TX: A beautiful historic church situated in the oldest Polish settlement in Texas

According to the Catechism of the Catholic Church, “An indulgence is a remission before God of the temporal punishment due to sins whose guilt has already been forgiven, which the faithful Christian who is duly disposed gains under certain prescribed conditions through the action of the Church which, as the minister of redemption, dispenses and applies with authority the treasury of the satisfactions of Christ and the saints... The faithful can gain indulgences for themselves or apply them to the dead.”

Indulgencia Plenaria Otorgada a Fieles

Con motivo de los Aniversarios de la Arquidiócesis de San Antonio

El Papa Francisco ha concedido a los fieles una Indulgencia Plenaria por el sesquicentenario (150° aniversario) de la erección canónica de la Diócesis de San Antonio, creada el 28 de agosto de 1874, así como por el centenario (100° aniversario) de la elevación a Arquidiócesis Metropolitana de San Antonio el 3 de agosto de 1926. La indulgencia es válida entre el 1 de enero de 2024 y el 31 de diciembre de 2026. Los fieles bautizados que se comprometan al desapego del pecado y sigan los pasos según la tradición y el derecho de la Iglesia Católica, reciben esta indulgencia estando en estado de gracia al **finalizar las obras prescritas a continuación:**

- Visitar devotamente uno de los sitios designados y rezar el Padre Nuestro y el Credo
- Cumplir con las tres condiciones habituales. La confesión sacramental, la Comunión Eucarística (recibir la Sagrada Comunión) y orar por las intenciones del Papa
- Aquellos que por edad, enfermedad u otras circunstancias no puedan salir de su hogar, pueden obtener la indulgencia uniéndose espiritualmente a las celebraciones de los aniversarios y ofreciendo sus sufrimientos a Dios

Los sitios designados son:

- La Catedral de San Fernando, San Antonio, TX: Una de las catedrales en funcionamiento continuo más antiguas de los Estados Unidos
- Iglesia Católica de Santa María, Fredericksburg, TX: Una hermosa e histórica iglesia ubicada en el corazón de Texas Hill Country
- Iglesia Católica del Sagrado Corazón, Uvalde, TX: La comunidad que experimentó el horrible tiroteo en la escuela donde diecinueve estudiantes y dos maestros perdieron la vida en 2022. Es una comunidad que necesita sanación.
- Iglesia Católica de Santiago, Gonzales, TX: Una comunidad de fe ubicada en la parte este de la Arquidiócesis. Es aquí donde se escuchó inicialmente el grito de batalla por la independencia de Texas.
- Iglesia Católica Inmaculada Concepción de la Santísima Virgen María, Panna Maria, TX: Una hermosa iglesia histórica situada en el asentamiento polaco más antiguo de Texas

Según el Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica, “La indulgencia es la remisión ante Dios de la pena temporal por los pecados, ya perdonados en cuanto a la culpa, que un fiel dispuesto y cumpliendo determinadas condiciones consigue por mediación de la Iglesia, la cual, como administradora de la redención, distribuye y aplica con autoridad el tesoro de las satisfacciones de Cristo y de los santos... Los fieles pueden ganar indulgencias para sí mismos o aplicarlas a los fieles difuntos.”
